- Aerodigestive tract foreign bodies
- Deep neck infections
- Salivary gland disease
- Craniofacial anomalies
- Head and neck trauma
- Temporal bone trauma
- Neoplasms of the head and neck
- Congenital nasal masses, stenosis and atresia
- Vascular and pigmented lesions of the head and neck

We also provide Audiology services, such as newborn hearing screening, hearing impairment management and cochlear implants.

Any relevant materials not accessible through CHKD's EHR, such as lab results, radiographs, and other accompanying reports should also be sent.
WHEN	will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?	Your patient's estimated wait time for an appointment is 2 - 4 weeks, depending on where the patient will be seen.
