4. EPSDT & ABA Therapy

Contact a case manager at social services to get a screening for EPSDT (Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment) so they can do a DMAS-7 (medical needs assessment/personal care services) on your child. This will allow you to access ABA therapy and Personal Care since you already have Medicaid.
